- Cultural & contemplative

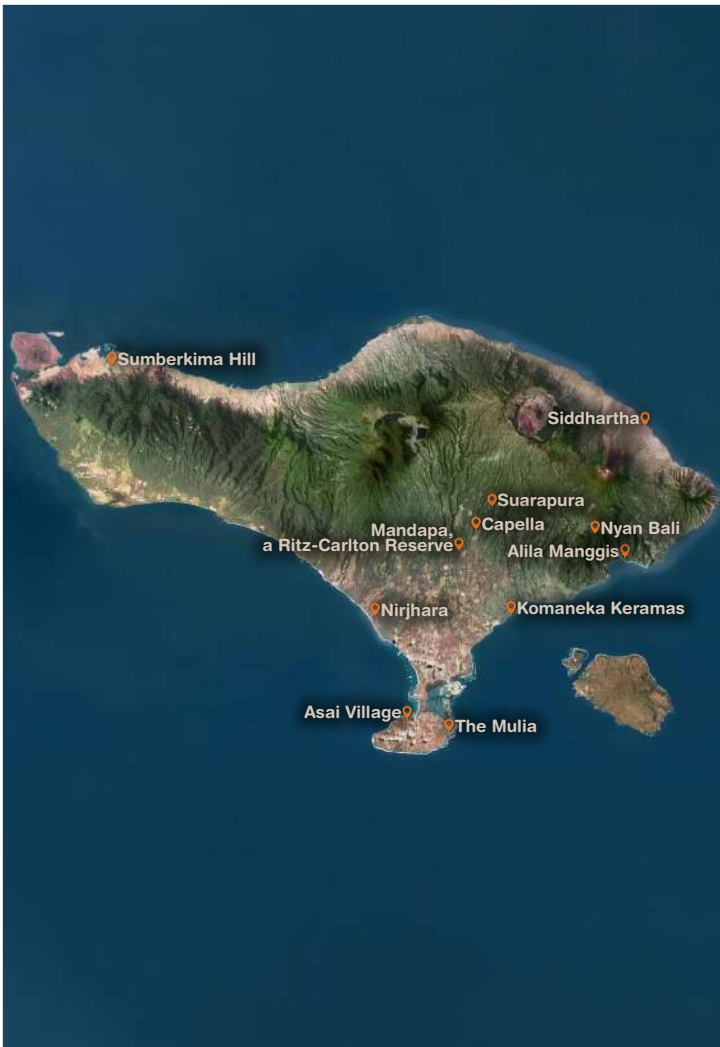
Step 2 – Choose Your Home Base

WHERE THE OCEAN GREET'S YOU

*For gentle arrivals and effortless departures. Salt air.
Horizon lines. Slow mornings.*

BEST FOR: A proper sauna reset and spa mornings that melt the jet lag away.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Sunset walk along Jimbaran Beach before dinner:** walk the curve of the bay as fishing boats return and the sky turns copper — it's Bali at its simplest and most honest.
- **Dinner at Cuca:** a thoughtful first night or last one — creative tapas rooted in local ingredients, prepared without rush. Our home and a product of 14 years of complete dedication.

THE MULIA

*Impressive beachfront scale.
Immaculate service.
A breakfast worth waking up for.
\$\$\$ - A Beautiful Indulgence.*

BEST FOR: Long beach walks and claiming your spot by the sea without compromise.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Watching traditional fishermen at first light:** at sunrise, painted jukung boats glide across the horizon — a quiet reminder that Bali's coastline still feeds families before it entertains visitors.
- **Dinner at Cuca:** step outside the resort bubble for an evening shaped by Indonesian produce and bold, unexpected flavors.





ALILA MANGGIS

Understated beachfront serenity.

Clean lines.

Soft, contemplative mornings.

\$\$ - Comfortably Considered.

BEST FOR: Absolute relaxation — where even your to-do list takes a holiday.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **A day at Virgin Beach:** Bali's most beautiful beach and one of the East's rare white-sand stretches, still relaxed and undeveloped — a place to swim, read, and forget what time it is.
- **Visit a traditional salt farm:** watch seawater transformed by sun and patience into mineral-rich salt, made the same way for generations along this coast.

KOMANEKA KERAMAS

Spacious rooms.

Quiet stretch of coast.

Perfect if you want waves without crowds.

\$\$\$ - *A Beautiful Indulgence.*

BEST FOR: Private coastal luxury with space to breathe — and waves as your soundtrack.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Watching surfers at Keramas:** at dawn, surfers paddle into powerful reef breaks with Mount Agung in the distance — wild, rhythmic and quietly beautiful.
- **Tegenungan Waterfall:** arrive early and stand in the cool mist before the crowds — water has always been sacred here.



WHERE NATURE BREATHS

*Filtered light through palm leaves.
Mornings wrapped in mist.
Time moving at its natural pace.*

BEST FOR: A river sanctuary experience wrapped in quiet, polished comfort.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Rafting on the Ayung River:** float past jungle, stone carvings, and hidden waterfalls — adventure softened by green silence.
- **Tegenungan Waterfall:** a dramatic cascade close to Ubud, best experienced in the early morning calm.



CAPELLA

*Immersive jungle glamping.
Theatrical yet intimate.
An experience more than a hotel.
\$\$\$ - Once-in-a-Lifetime Magic.*

BEST FOR: Living out your jungle explorer fantasy — with very good sheets.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Campuhan Ridge Walk:** a gentle morning walk above Ubud's valleys, where mist lifts slowly from rolling green hills.
- **Gunung Kawi Temple:** descend through rice fields to 11th-century shrines carved into rock — history felt in your soul.

WHERE BALI FEELS WILD AGAIN

*Open skies. Fewer voices.
Cliff edges, quiet hills, empty coastline.
Space to think. Space to simply be.*



Remote & untouched

SUMBERKIMA HILL

Panoramic calm.

Different villas for different rhythms.

We love Villa Asmara 1 for its openness and views.

\$\$\$\$ - *A Beautiful Indulgence.*

BEST FOR: Front-row views of volcanoes meeting the sea — especially at golden hour.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Kayak to Gili Putih sandbank:** paddle toward a strip of white sand that appears and disappears with the tide — dreamy and unforgettable.
- **Spot deer on Menjangan Island or West Bali National Park:** see wild deer wander in one of Bali's last protected landscapes.



SIDDHARTHA

*Diving. Stillness.
Spa afternoons.
Time moves slower here.
\$\$\$ - Comfortably Considered.*

BEST FOR: Honest home-style cooking after a day spent underwater.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Dive the USAT Liberty shipwreck:** walk straight from the shore into one of the world's most accessible wreck dives, now alive with coral and fish.
- **Tulamben Traditional Market at sunrise:** watch farmers trade volcanic-soil harvests in the cool morning air — simple, local, unfiltered.

NIRJHARA

Architectural elegance.

Water, jungle, space.

Boutique and beautifully composed.

\$\$\$ - *A Beautiful Indulgence.*

BEST FOR: Waterfall swims, yoga at sunrise, and spa afternoons that stretch into evening.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Nyanyi Beach:** wide black sand, dramatic cliffs, and hardly anyone around — Bali without the noise.
- **Tanah Lot Temple at dusk:** arrive early to see the sea temple before the crowds — waves, offerings, and quiet devotion.



WHERE RITUAL SHAPES THE LANDSCAPE

*Sacred waters at dawn.
Village rhythms.
Offerings placed gently on doorsteps.*



Cultural & contemplative

SUARAPURA

*Arguably the most serene rice field view on the island.
Japanese-inspired simplicity.
Seba is a host who genuinely cares.
\$\$\$ - Comfortably Considered.*

BEST FOR: Watching fog slowly lift from the valley at dawn while the farmers work on the rice fields.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Sebatu rice field walk:** wander through working terraces where water flows gently between paddies and farmers move with steady rhythm.
- **Sunrise visit to Tirta Empul water temple:** witness morning purification rituals in sacred spring water before the island fully wakes.



NYAN BALI

One house. Total privacy.

A hidden jungle retreat that feels less like a hotel and more like a well-kept secret.

\$\$\$ - *A Beautiful Indulgence.*

BEST FOR: Disappearing — gracefully — into the jungle for a few uninterrupted days.

MEMORABLE EXPERIENCES

- **Sidemen rice terraces with Mount Agung views:** stroll among bright green paddies with Bali's most sacred volcano rising in the distance.
- **Visit Besakih, Bali's Mother Temple:** stand on the slopes of Mount Agung and observe Balinese Hindu ceremonies unfolding in daily life.

A FINAL WORD

Remember, Bali is no meant to be consumed. It is meant to be felt...

But we know you will get hungry, and when you do, here is a list of our favourite restaurants around the island (and beyond!).

And of course, we'd love to welcome you to our home, Cuca – the perfect way to ease into Bali, or to say goodbye without rushing.
